### PARADE REGULATIONS:

1. All Entries INCLUDING TOWING VEHICLE MUST BE DECORATED - ANTIQUES EXCLUDED.
2. Parade marshals have the right to remove entries.
3. All entry registration forms must be accompanied by a certificate of insurance.
4. Provision for emergency towing must be available for all motorized entries (i.e. tow hook, tow chain or other such device).
5. Arrival in marshalling area 8:30 a.m. Parade committee will usher entry to appropriate judging category area
6. JUDGING - 9:30 a.m.
7. For safety reasons NO MATERIAL or CANDY may be thrown from a moving entry. Parade marshals retain the right to remove any entry which is considered dangerous to the progress of the parade.
8. Float riders MUST be safely secured to float and it is advisable to carry a fire extinguisher.
9. All animals must be treated humanely and be feed and watered before and after the parade.
10. Maximum height for entries is limited to 5.1m or 16 feet 8 inches. This specification is enforced by the Highway Traffic Act.
