- All Entries INCLUDING TOWING VEHICLE MUST BE DECORATED ANTIQUES EXCLUDED.
- Parade marshals have the right to remove entries.

 All entry registration forms must be accompanied by a certificate of insurance.

 Provision for emergency towing must be available for all motorized entries (i.e. tow hook, tow chain or other such device).
 - Arrival in marshalling area 8:30 a.m. Parade committee will usher entry to appropriate judging category area JUDGING - 9:30 a.m.
 For safety reasons NO MATERIAL or CANDY may be thrown from a moving entry. Parade marshals retain

- the right to remove any entry which is considered dangerous to the progress of the parade. Float riders MUST be safely secured to float and it is advisable to carry a fire extinguisher. All animals must be treated humanely and be feed and watered before and after the parade. Maximum height for entries is limited to 5.1m or 16 feet 8 inches. This specification is enforced by the Highway Traffic Act.
